^{Sabbath שבת} ^{(stop working) (time)} ^(7th) and he rested on the seventh day 

^[...six days of creation...] ^(...finish make...) from **all** his work which he had made.

✚ Genesis 2:3 — God's Rest Day

God finished His work. He stopped. He rested.

God blessed the 7th day and made it **holy** (special, set apart).

👤 Why? Did God get tired?

✗ No! God does not get tired (Isaiah 40:28).

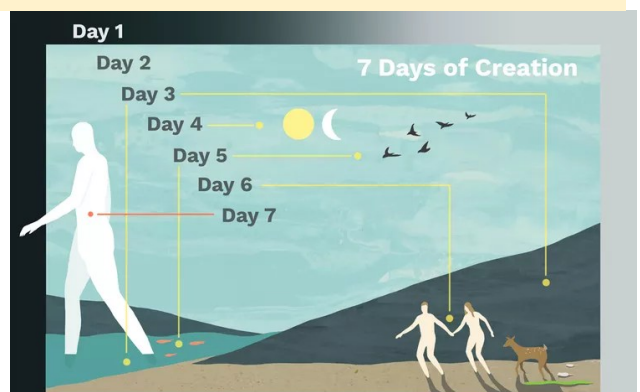
✓ He rested to **show a pattern**: Work, then stop.

He was **giving a picture** for humans to follow.

* God rested to show His work was done

* Sabbath = stop, rest, trust

* Today, we rest in Jesus — not just one day, but every day



Genesis 2:3

And God blessed the seventh day,
and sanctified it: because that in it
he had rested from all his work
which God created and made.

🧠 What is the Sabbath?

- **Sabbath** means “rest” or “stop” 🛑
- God made the 7th day **special** to remind us:
 - He is the **Creator** 🌍
 - We must **rest and trust Him**, not only work 🙌

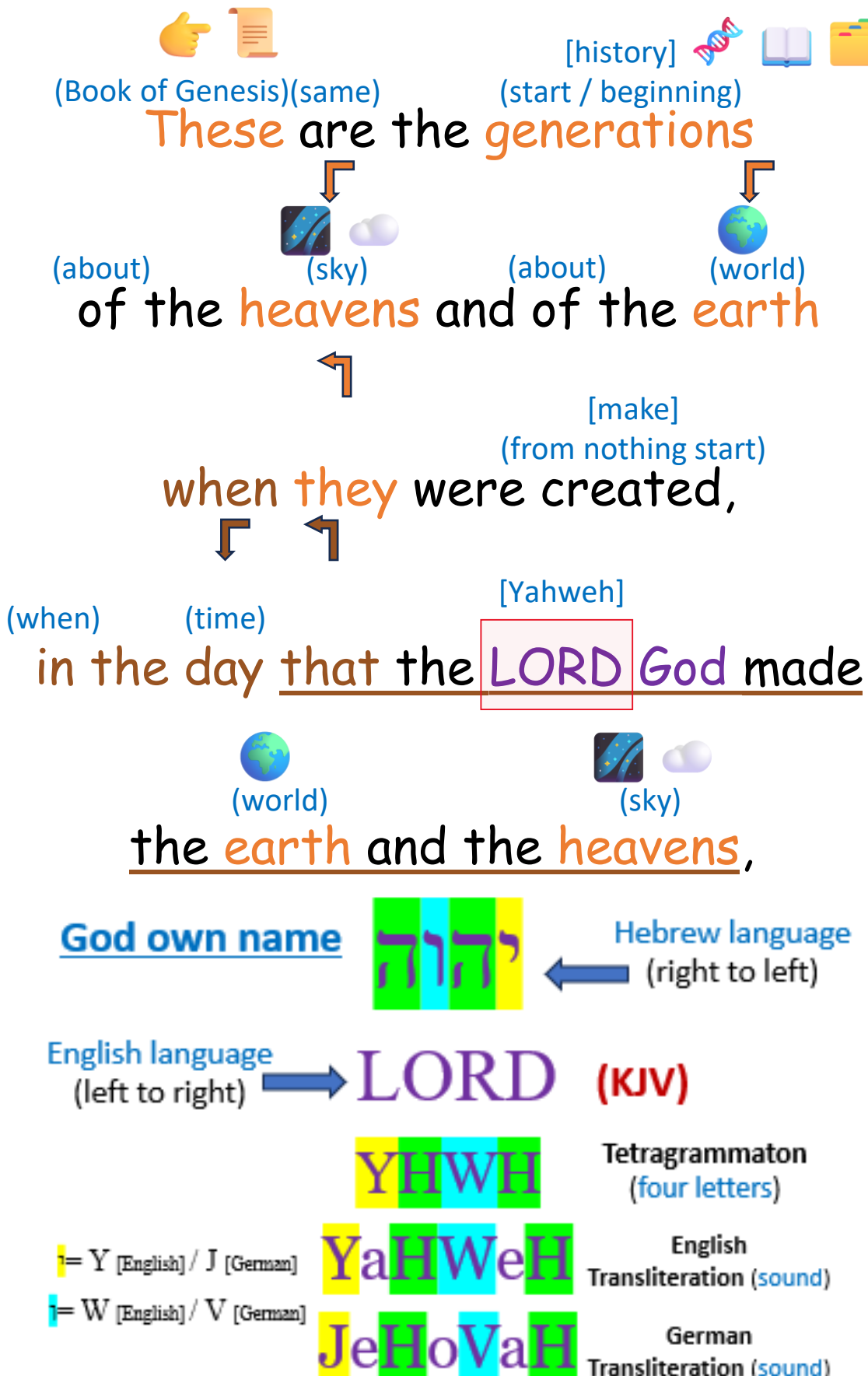
📖 Later, in the Law (Exodus 20), the Sabbath became a command for Israel

But it was **only a shadow** of something bigger...

✚ JESUS is the true Sabbath

- Jesus gives us **real rest** — rest from sin, fear, and trying to save ourselves
- In Jesus, we **rest in God's finished work**, like God rested at creation
 - 🛑 We do not keep Sabbath to earn salvation
 - ✅ We **trust in Jesus** to give us **eternal rest**

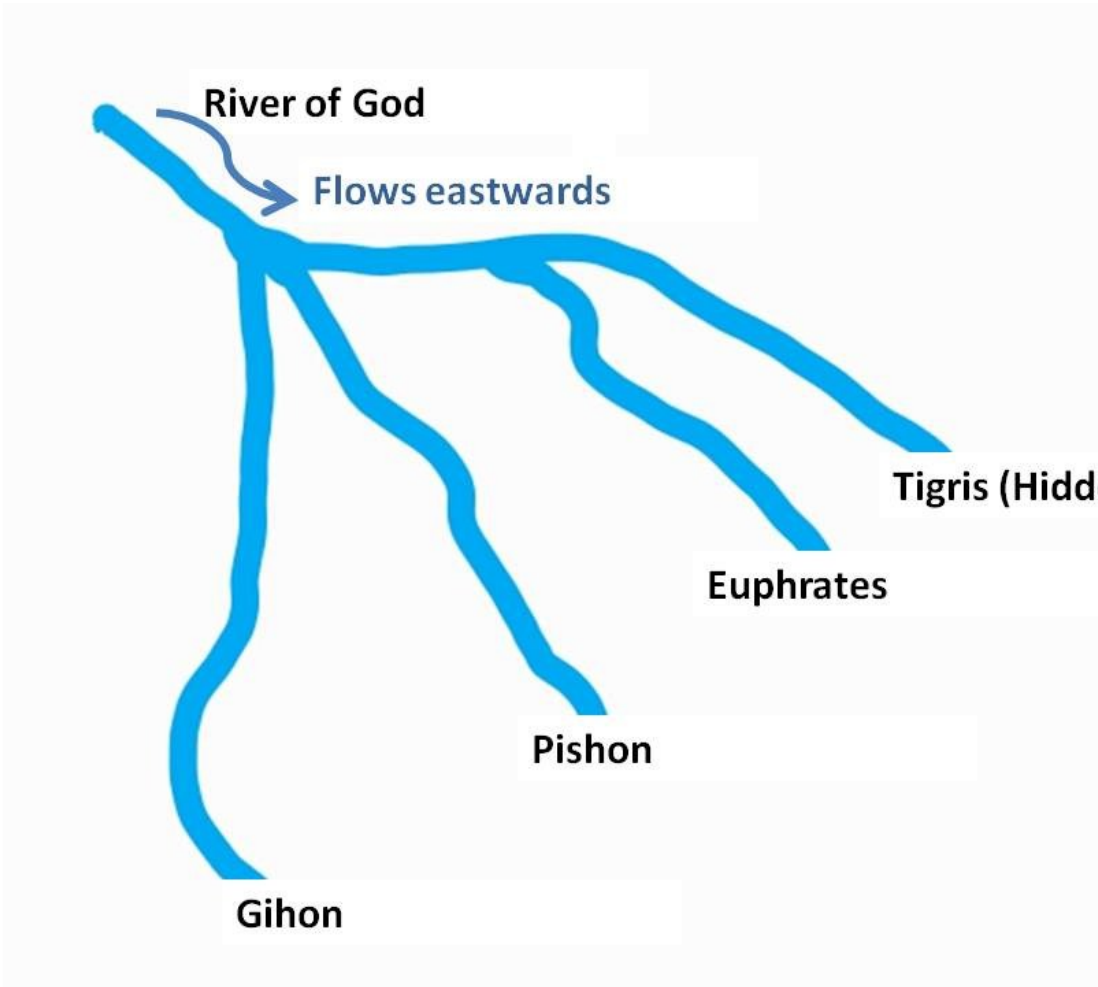
